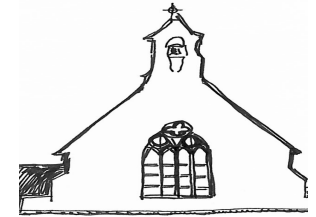

Masses, Liturgies and events this Week:

Holy Week relives the story of Jesus Christ's passion, death and resurrection. Lent is completed on Thursday and the Easter Triduum begins with the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper. Holy Week reaches its high point with the Easter Vigil and closes on Easter Sunday.

Palm Sunday Killavullen 7.00pm (Sat. Vigil) & 11.30am Annakisha 10.00am;

Jesus is greeted at the gates of Jerusalem as the Messiah. He arrived on a donkey to show that "though his state was divine, Jesus did not cling to his equality with God." (2nd R.) At the beginning of this Mass we remember the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. This year, the proclamation of the Passion is from the Gospel of Luke.

The shorter form of the Passion will be proclaimed at Sunday morning Masses. The Second Collection is for the Parish Buildings' Fund. Following the 11.30am Mass please join the Pastoral Council as we make a Holy Week walk from the Church around the Monanimy Loop

Good Friday, April 19 Day of Fasting and Abstinence

Annakisha: Stations of the Cross: 3.00pm (outdoors, weather permitting)

Killavullen: Celebration of the Lord's Passion: 7.30pm
The liturgy is made up of four parts: readings from the bible, including the passion of Jesus in the Gospel of John; the universal prayer-intentions of the Church; the veneration of the Cross; and the rite of Communion. *At these liturgies there will be a collection for the upkeep of Holy Places of Christianity in Palestine.*

Holy Saturday, April 20

On Holy Saturday the Church waits at the Lord's tomb. The Altar is left bare and Mass is not celebrated. The Easter Vigil continues this waiting and then celebrates the moment of the Lord's resurrection.

Killavullen: Easter Vigil 8.00pm (with Paschal Fire and Choir)

1. Service of Light – the Paschal Candle is lit.
2. Liturgy of the Word: the Bible on the history of salvation
3. Liturgy of Baptism – the renewal of Baptismal Vows
4. Liturgy of Eucharist
