


# Parish of Killavullen & Annakisha

**Pentecost Sunday:** Today's Mass marks the origins of the Church. *Pentecost* (Greek for "50<sup>th</sup> day") has echoes of the Jewish harvest festival called *Shavout*, which was held seven weeks and one day after the Passover (the Christian Easter). **1<sup>st</sup> Reading:** The story of the first Pentecost: the disciples are given the courage to share their faith. **2<sup>nd</sup> Reading:** The Spirit we receive at Baptism makes us part of God's family. With Jesus we can say "Abba, Father". **Gospel:** Jesus promises his disciples his spirit to be their supporter or "Advocate". *A children's activity sheet based on today's Gospel is available from the Usher as you come to church.*
