The Second Collection at this Mass is the monthly collection for the parish buildings' fund. Work is underway in the East Gable Window of Killavullen Church. The bottom third of the frame, which has decayed due to wet-rot will, be replaced with pitch-pine timber. A metal upstand will be built into the sill to prevent a recurrence of water ingress at this point. The stained glass, originally installed in the 1920s, has been removed for restoration. Each panel will be re-leaded and the broken pieces will be replaced. The panels will be secured to the renovated frame using stainless steel saddlebars (the previous supports had given way, causing the window to buckle). As the renovated window will be watertight and well supported, the stormglazing will not be refitted. This will eliminate glare, creating an aesthetically pleasing view of the window from the church-yard. The window will be lit from the inside at night-time. The sacristy and **meeting room window** will also be renovated as part of this project. The existing frame will be repaired and clear double glazed units will replace the existing glass. This will open a view from the upstairs meeting room and allow it to be ventilated. Thank you for your financial contributions which enable us to complete this maintenance and improvement work.
