Work commenced this week on repairing one of the windows at Killavullen Church: the timberwork will revert to the original (pre-1995) design, which was retained in the front gable window. Clear glazing and better ventilation will make the upstairs meeting room an attractive venue for the children's Liturgy of the Word, and other small group gatherings.

Parish Accounts 2019: The accountant appointed by the Diocese (Mary Gleeson-Cronin) has approved the parish's accounts for 2019. They will now be formally audited by Deloitte. Please get in contact if you have any queries in relation to the items listed here. Thank you for your generosity. Parish income has collapsed since the Covid crisis (as it has for many charities, businesses and individuals). For the time being we are drawing on savings and donations made from January-March to meet expenses like the annual cost of insurance (€7,151), paid this week. I will be calling on your renewed generosity when the crisis passes and normal Church services

resume in July, God willing. Weekly Offerings, Station / Easter Offerings and donations to the Parish Buildings Fund offerings can also be made at this time to the Parish Office in Ballygriffin, ideally using the minienvelopes as this will allow for the reclaim of taxes from Revenue.
