- The obligation for Catholics to attend Sunday Mass is suspended at this time. If you decide not to attend Sunday Mass, please participate in Church life through live streaming services on radio, TV and the Internet. You might also consider coming to a weekday Mass.
- Please observe respiratory etiquette at church. Arriving to church early and leaving a few minutes afterwards will help avoid crowding at the doors. At Killavullen the side entrance (Nano Nagle Porch) is open.
- Sanitize your hands on entering and leaving the church. Sit with your family group and two metres away from others. Make greater use of our front seats. Observe respiratory etiquette.
- Consider wearing a mask / faceguard, especially in confined spaces.
- Communion is to be received on the hand from the celebrant. Please observe social distancing in the communion procession. If you wish to wait after Mass you can also receive communion at that time.

Killavullen Church: Work on servicing the windows and installing a stainless steel mesh at window openings was completed this week.
