Eighteenth Sunday: *The Lord who feeds us.*

1st Reading: God did not just create the universe but also sustains it by his love. Divine love is made visible in our support for one another, especially in this time of the Covid19 pandemic. Does my faith in God motivate me to help those in need?

Psalm 144 R./ *You open wide your hand, O Lord, you grant our desires.*

2nd Reading: God has been visible to us in Jesus Christ.

Gospel: The miracle of the loaves and the fishes. It is often little gestures that matter. Jesus transforms the small gifts we bring before God and the world and makes them into something for the good of all. The bread and wine we bring to the altar become the presence of the risen Christ: the promise that God's is with us and nourishes us with bread from heaven.

Entrance Hymn –

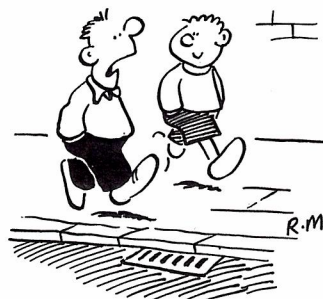
Christ be near at either hand,

Covid-19 Pandemic and Public Masses.

- If you are feeling unwell, or have any of the symptoms of Covid-19, or have been in contact with someone who has recently had the Virus, then please stay at home and participate in church life via the media.
- Wash your hands before leaving home and on returning from Mass. Sanitize your hands on entering the church and as you leave. Consider wearing a mask / face guard while at Mass. Arriving to church early and leaving a few minutes afterwards will help avoid crowding at the doors – as well as being an opportunity for personal prayer.
- “Please sit here” stickers have been installed to mark the spot where you or your family group should sit! Sit two metres away from all other persons or household groups. Make greater use of our front seats. Observe respiratory etiquette while at church.
- Communion is distributed by the celebrant onto your hand. If you wish to wait on after Mass you can also receive communion at that time.
- Our churches are well ventilated and regularly sanitized thanks to the efforts of our sacristans, volunteer cleaners, and CE workers.
