<u>Second Sunday of Advent (Gaudete Sunday)</u>: Today we celebrate our joy on hearing the Good News of salvation. The first reading says that the Messiah will restore the people's freedom and full health following their long and hard exile in captivity. (That is a promise that resonates with us in this year of restrictions.). St Paul reminds the Thessalonians that their reason to be happy is Christ: "May he keep you safe and blameless". In the Gospel of St John, Jesus is the *lux mundi - the light of the world*. Like John the Baptist we too can witness to the light by the example of our good and holy lives
