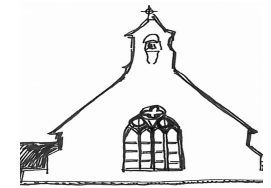


Parish of Killavullen and Annakisha 20.49

Fourth Sunday of Advent:

Antiphon: *Prepare ye the way of the Lord, prepare ye the way of the Lord.*

1st Reading: David builds a house for the Ark: the container for the 10 commandments and other signs of the covenant (promise / agreement) God made with Moses. It was believed to embody God's presence.

Psalm: 88: The covenant was renewed in the person of King David, who became God's Messiah ("anointed one").

2nd Reading: A new covenant with God was made known to us in Jesus.

Gospel: The Annunciation: The angel invites Mary to become the mother of God. She becomes the ark of the new covenant.
