Fourteenth Sunday *The Church is a Prophet for God.*

1st Reading: Ezekiel is sent as prophet to Israel, even if the people will not listen. God's message is sometimes in opposition with the values of society.

Psalm 122: A plea for God's mercy for our sins.

2nd Reading: St Paul's awareness of his failings made him all the more appreciative of God's grace and mercy.

Gospel: Jesus is not accepted by his own people; because of their lack of faith in him, there were fewer signs of God's presence.
