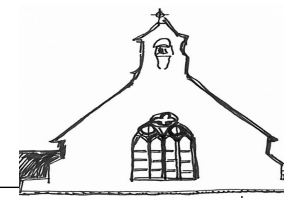

Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time *Christ makes us his apostles*

1st Reading: The vocation story of the prophet Isaiah. While visiting the temple, Isaiah had a vision of God. Freed from his sense of guilt, he became a worthy servant of the Lord.

2nd Reading: The word “apostle” means “one who is sent”; sent by God to proclaim the Good News. St Paul never met Jesus of Nazareth, but did encounter the Risen Lord on the road to Damascus. It was a defining moment in his life: he saw in Christ the beginning of God’s new creation.

Gospel: The vocation story of Simon Peter. Like Isaiah and St Paul, Simon has experienced the “*yirat Adonai*” (the fear of the Lord), when he witnessed a miracle. In the Bible, the “fear of the Lord” is a respect for God’s presence in the world and is regarded as the beginning of all wisdom. Jesus points out to Simon Peter his true role in life as the leaders of the apostles.
