<u>First Sunday of Lent</u> Led by the Spirit of God

1st Reading: At the end of his long life, Moses remembers the story of his people. God had led them from slavery in Egypt into the promised land, a forty year journey. In thanksgiving the people thank God before the altar.

Responsorial Psalm 90: Those who put their trust in the Lord will be delivered from the many threats to life.

 2^{nd} Reading: Jesus is the Lord who has conquered sin and death. We cry out to him from our hearts; we confess our faith in him with our lips.

Gospel: Jesus is tempted in the desert. He puts trust in his heavenly Father ahead of possessions and power. During Lent we are invited to imitate Jesus in the desert, *fasting* from some of the luxuries and comforts of our lives in order to make more time for God (*prayer*) and others, especially those with greater needs (*almsgiving*). Putting ourselves to the test by prayer, fasting and almsgiving, will make us stronger in faith and in virtue.
