Pentecost Sunday (*Whitsunday*) *The fifty days of Easter conclude with this feastday which marks the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the disciples. They would be among the 'first fruits' of a new creation.*

1st Reading: Those who are gifted with the presence of the Holy Spirit are able to communicate the love of God to others, friend and foe alike, in much the same way that the first disciples could speak many languages. The Spirit enables us.

2nd Reading: The Spirit of Christ in us means we can address God as *Abba* (the Aramaic word "dad"). We are called to honour the spiritual aspect of our lives.

Gospel: The Holy Spirit is our Advocate, the one who pleads our case before God and helps us to find our peace with God.

At Pentecost Sunday, this weekend we welcome children who celebrated their Confirmation at Annakisha Church on March 23. The *confirmandi* have reflected on the meaning of the sacrament during the past week: their preparations, the day itself and its effect in their lives now that they are full members of the Catholic Church. Many of them will also make a pledge to abstain from alcoholic drink and illegal drugs for a specified time:

In thanksgiving to God for life and health,
I promise not to drink alcohol until I am __ years old.
I also promise never to take dangerous or illegal drugs
and to help other people to do the same.
I ask the Holy Spirit to help me to keep these promises.
