Trinity Sunday Today we rejoice that the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit is with us.

1st Reading: It was the wisdom of God that brought creation into being. Wisdom (*Sophia*) in the bible resembles our understanding of the Holy Spirit. It is God's invisible presence that animates and unites all of creation.

Psalm: The wonders of creation point us to the Creator.

2nd Reading: Suffering can bring patience and perseverance. We can learn to bear our crosses in life when we receive the gift of God's Spirit.

Gospel: Jesus promises his Spirit to help us understand God as our loving Father.

Tom Barry Memorial at Annakisha: The restored railings and monument will be unveiled this Sunday afternoon as part of a symposium on local history that will begin at 2.30 with music by the Thomas Davis Pipe Band. Five short talks will follow: on the events of August 19, 1906, when the monument was erected, the results of a recent archaeological dig at Annakisha, an incident from the War of Independence, local folklore, the life of Tom Barry and the conservation of national monuments. A brochure on the day is available at church doorways.

The inscription on the monument reads:

"In affectionate memory of Tom Barry, patriot, friend and defender of the oppressed, who throughout more than twenty years of struggle for the abolition of landlordism and the freedom of Ireland led the people of his native district to victory with heroic courage and with all the enduring virtues of a Christian Irishman,

this memorial is erected by his grateful countrymen.

Born 23.3.1850 Died 9.5.1904. God Save Ireland."
