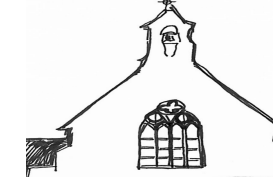

**2<sup>nd</sup> Reading:** Paul writes to Timothy that we should be prepared to preach the Gospel even when it is unpopular, but to always do so patiently and in charity.

**Gospel:** Jesus tells his disciples to persist in their prayer. Making time for prayer strengthens our faith; and without faith is very hard to pray. God answers our prayers in mysterious ways.
