Second Sunday of Advent

1st Reading: The coming of the Messiah will usher in a new era of peace when the gifts of knowing God and of wisdom will be available to all.

 2^{nd} Reading: St Paul tells the Romans that they should treat each other in the same friendly way "as Christ treated you."

Gospel: John the Baptist is a fearsome figure (the original "fire and brimstone" preacher) who is critical of those (like the Pharisees) who don't practice what they preach. He prepares a way for the Messiah by his simple lifestyle and by the sharing of his faith.
