First Sunday of Lent

1st *Reading:* The Book of Genesis is a telling story about the goodness of God's creation, spoiled by the sins of humanity. The ongoing presence of evil in the world (represented in the story by the serpent) is our *original sin*. It brought about death, something God had never intended.

Responsorial Psalm: Lent is a time to repent of sin. By the grace of God's forgiveness, we can acquire, again, a "pure heart" and a "steadfast spirit".

 2^{nd} Reading: Jesus Christ heralded the dawn of a new creation. His life, death and resurrection has "justified" humanity in the sight of God and restored eternal life.

Gospel: The season of Lent is based on the 40 days that Jesus spent in the desert. When we deny ourselves, we too will face temptation.
