Responsorial Psalm: Jesus Christ is our shepherd.

2<sup>nd</sup> Reading: When we are baptised, we become children of God's light.

Gospel: Jesus heals a man who has been born blind and he challenges the spiritual blindness of Pharisees who will not recognise him as the Messiah. During the season of Lent, may we see God, the world and our own lives in a new way, enlightened by the light of Christ.
