Holy Week relives the story of Jesus Christ's passion, death and resurrection. Lent is completed by Thursday and the Easter Triduum begins with the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper. Holy Week reaches its high point with the Easter Vigil and closes on Easter Sunday.

Palm Sunday, April 1 - 2 Killavullen 7.00pm (Sat. Vigil) & 11.30am Annakisha 10.00am

Jesus is greeted at the gates of Jerusalem as the Messiah. He arrived on a donkey to show that "though his state was divine, Jesus did not cling to his equality with God." $(2^{nd} R.)$

At the 11.30am Mass a Passion Play will replace the reading of the Gospel.

Good Friday, April 7 Day of Fasting and Abstinence

Annakisha Church grounds: Stations of the Cross: 3.00pm

Killavullen: Celebration of the Lord's Passion: 7.30pm

This liturgy has a particularly sombre tone as we relive the mystery of Christ's saving death. The Passion Play will replace the proclamation of the Gospel. It will be followed by the universal prayer-intentions of the Church; the veneration of the Cross; and the rite of Communion.

At these liturgies there will be a collection for the upkeep of Holy Places of Christianity in Palestine; the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be celebrated following both liturgies.

Holy Saturday, April 8

On Holy Saturday the Church waits at the Lord's tomb. The Altar is left bare and the sacraments are not celebrated. The Easter Vigil continues this waiting and then celebrates the moment of the Lord's resurrection at night.
