Easter Sunday We are an Easter people; Alleluia is our song.

First Reading: Peter addresses the people of Israel with the kervgma (the proclamation) of the Good News, a summary of our faith. Responsorial Psalm 117: A song of praise to God. We praise the Lord for conquering death in the resurrection of his Son. He was the stone rejected by the builders that became the cornerstone of a new covenant.

Second Reading: The Good News moves our hearts and minds to heavenly things. Through our baptism, we are "hidden with Christ in God." Gospel: Peter and John hear the Good News from Mary Magdalene. The empty tomb provided sure evidence for the resurrection.
