The recessional collection today will be the monthly collection for the Parish Buildings Fund: this year the collection is reserved for the payment of repairs to the sacristy roof at Annakisha and planned repairs to sections of the cemetery wall. At Killavullen it is planned to paint three of the exterior walls, later this Summer, and carry out repairs to the bellcote and the sanctuary window framing at the same time.

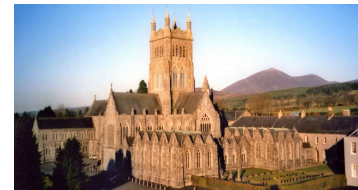

Summer Collection: Many thanks to all who have contributed to the Summer (formerly, 'Petrol' / 'Oats') collection this year, one of five collections over the course of the year that make up your priest's income. Envelopes for the collection are at church doors and are also enclosed (in blue) in the box of envelopes if your household is registered with the parish.

Parish Pastoral Council: A Parish Pilgrimage to Mount Melleray Abbey and Ardmore, County Waterford will take place on the Feast of the Assumption (Tuesday, August 15), leaving Killavullen at 9.00am and arriving for Mass with the community of Cistercian Monks at Mount Melleray at 10.30am. Mass will be followed by Tea/Coffee/ homemade scones and an opportunity to spend some time visiting the public areas of the Monastery. From there the coach will make its way through Cappoquin and Clashmore to the lower reaches of the River Blackwater and onto Ardmore where there will be lunch at the highly rated Whitehorses Restaurant. Following lunch, there will be time to take a stroll by the strand or walk the Ardmore Cliff Loop, which begins at St Declan's Well and ends at the ruins of Ardmore Cathedral.
