Twenty Seventh Sunday: *We are workers in the Vineyard of the Lord. First Reading:* Isaiah compares the glory of God's creation to a vineyard that has been badly managed by its caretakers.

Responsorial Psalm 79: A prayer that God will restore the vineyard.

Second Reading: Our faith in God and fellowship with Jesus gives us a peace that the world cannot take away.

Gospel: Another one of Matthew's vineyard parables: God is the landowner who planted the vineyard, but it only yields bitter fruit. Even his only Son would become a cornerstone rejected by the people. With Christ, there is an opportunity to restore God's kingdom of justice, peace and love.
