First Sunday of Lent

First Reading: Following the Great Flood, God establishes a covenant with Noah and his descendants. Its symbol is the rainbow – a fitting sign of the union between heaven and earth. For Christians, Jesus Christ is the sign of a new and definitive Covenant with God.

Psalm 24: Our faith teaches us the correct path to follow.

Second Reading: The Letter of Saint Peter draws a parallel between the waters of the great flood and the waters of baptism. In Baptism we are born to new life with God.

Gospel: Before his public ministry Jesus took 40 days alone in the desert. He was tempted to take the direction of his life away from God. The experience tested his faith and made stronger his proclamation of the Good News.
