Second Sunday of Lent Faith makes our life shine with God's glory. First Reading: The story of our faith begins with Abraham who acknowledged the existence of the one true God when he stared up at the stars one night. Abraham puts his faith in the God he cannot see; his covenant with God brings many blessings.

Psalm 26: Those who hope in the Lord will see God's goodness. *Second Reading:* Our true homeland is heaven; we will share in God's glory. *Gospel:* The *transfiguration* reveals the divine nature of Jesus to the inner group of his disciples (who would also be with him at the Garden of Gethsemane). In the vision, Jesus stands alongside Elijah (representative of the Old Testament prophets) and Moses (the bringer of the Torah/Law)

- The Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated on Saturday evening at 6.30pm in the Reconciliation Room.
- At Masses this weekend (and every other weekend) a Children's Liturgy of the Word will take place.

- "Miss Margaret Sheehy, NT, appointed as an additional assistant teacher in Killavullen NS on 1st April 1982
- Prefab classroom opened for classes on 26th April 1982.
- A Parish Mission was held from Sunday, 25th April to Sunday 2nd May. Fr Angelus OFM Cap. and Fr Gabriel OFM Cap. conducted the mission
- 28 children from the parish, 21 from Killavullen School and seven from Ballygown received the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Church of the Resurrection, Mallow on 17th May 1982. Most Rev. Dr. Whelan CSsP performed the ceremony."
