Second Sunday of Easter

First Reading: The grace of the Lord's resurrection was evident in the many "signs and wonders" taking place in the early Church. *Psalm 117:* A song giving glory to God. Christ was the stone rejected by the builders that became the cornerstone of a new covenant. *Second Reading:* The opening of the apostle John's vision of the afterlife. Through his resurrection, Jesus has conquered death for ever. *May the faithful departed, including Pope Francis share in the new life of the Risen Christ.*

Gospel: Two of the appearances of the Risen Jesus: the disciples struggle to believe that he has been raised from the dead. The doubting Thomas represents our search for proof. *We gather "eight days later", to celebrate the Lord's resurrection. May we know the peace he offers and share it with others.*

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated on Saturday evening at 6.30pm in the Reconciliation Room and at any time requested. *At Masses this <u>weekend</u>* (and every other weekend) a *Children's Liturgy of the Word* takes place.
