Sixth Sunday of Easter The radiant glory of God

First Reading: The first Christians debated whether Gentiles could be baptized or should Christianity remain as a movement within Judaism. The disciples remembered the words of Jesus that the Gospel was intended for all of creation and all humanity.

Second Reading: The Kingdom of God is compared with a city built on the firm foundations of the Good News.

Gospel: In the farewell discourse, Jesus tells the disciples that he will be with them through the sending of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit, given to us at Baptism, is our Advocate and supporter throughout life, the source of our peace.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated on Saturday evening at 6.30pm in the Reconciliation Room and at any time requested. *At Masses next weekend (and every other weekend)* a *Children's Liturgy of the Word* takes place.
