Fourth Sunday of Advent

First reading: Writing in the Seventh Century BC, Isaiah anticipate the Messiah born of a maiden. **Second Reading:** King David, who lived circa 1000BC, was regarded as the first Messiah (anointed one of God); For St Paul, Jesus was the new Messiah, chosen by God to make a new covenant that would last forever.

Gospel: Joseph was engaged to marry Mary when she was found to be “with child through the Holy Spirit.” In his dreams he is told by an angel that Mary’s child is “Emmanuel”, which means “God-with-us.”

A Children’s Liturgy will take place at Masses this weekend. The sacrament of reconciliation is celebrated at 6.30pm on Saturdays in the Reconciliation Room of Killavullen Church or at any time requested.
