Sixth Sunday of Easter – Liturgy of the Word

First Reading: Philip, one of the Twelve Apostles, goes to a town in Samaria to share the Good News. The people believed in Jesus because of what he said and the signs and wonders they saw.

Psalms: A song of praise for God’s presence in the world.

Second Reading: Peter asks that we should be able to give reasons for our hope. Then, as now, the Christianity faces many hostile forces: always be courteous to those who do not share your beliefs.

Gospel: Today’s Gospel prepares us for the next weeks’ feasts of the Ascension and Pentecost. Jesus tells his disciples that he would no longer be physically present. Instead, his Spirit would remind us of his real-but-invisible presence. The Holy Spirit is an *advocate*, who speaks up for God’s presence and our *comforter* in times of distress.
