Fourteenth Sunday: *The Lord is kind and full of compassion*

Thank you for your generosity which maintains our parish buildings and grounds. As a registered charity we are expected to maintain accurately audited accounts. This also allows us to claim a tax rebate from Revenue. If your household is registered with the parish and donates more than €250 annually to this parish, we can claim back any taxes paid to the State on your donations. Last year (2025) this claim yielded a total of €14,721 to the parish from approximately 70 households. If your household donates more than €250 annually and has not completed a CHY3 form, we invite you to do so. The CHY3 form is available from the Sacristy or the Parish Office.

Summer Sunday Mass Schedule: Please note that we are introducing a Summer Mass schedule for some weekends of July and August 2026. For these weekends there will be two Sunday Masses as follows:

7.00pm - Vigil Mass in Annakisha Church.

10.00am - Morning Mass in Killavullen Church
